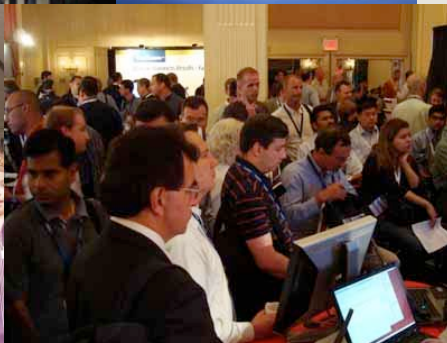


Moroccan American Community Center Convention

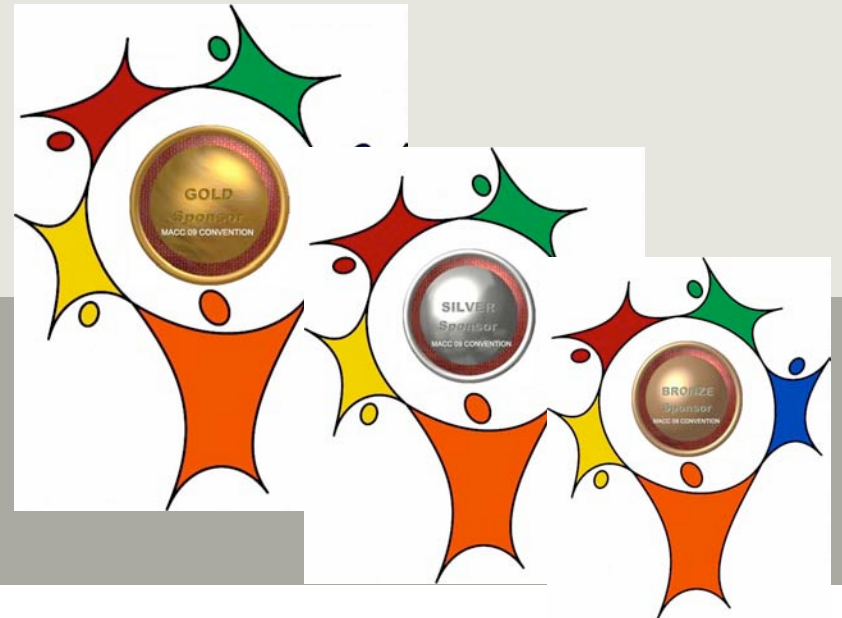
